

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Outing – Hadden Hill GC, Didcot 24/03/17

A slight re-jig of our fixture list saw us visiting Hadden Hill, where we play for 4 competitions. We play 36 holes for a Scratch Competition (gross score) and the same 36 holes for a Balance Competition (Nett Score). In addition we also mark the stableford scores for AM & PM Competitions. Our turnout for this outing consisted of 17 members and 2 guests. As usual, the coffee and bacon rolls were done to perfection and set us up for a nice morning round. Unfortunately the greens had recently been tined, which made putting quite challenging, resulting in lower stableford scores.

With 2 players tied on a gross score of 181 it was Dan Evans who won the Scratch Salver, on count back from Bill Fenn, who once again came runner up in the Scratch competition.

The Balance competition is the gross score minus the handicap to give a nett score and this was won by Bill Fenn on a score of 167, and Dan Evans was runner-up with 168.

The morning Stableford competition for the Konica Trophy was tied by 2 players on 32 points, but was won by Steve Simpson on count back, and the runner up was Bill Fenn.

The afternoon Stableford competition for the Whale Salver was won by Jim Wilson with 32 points, and the runner up was Dan Evans who beat Terry Baker on count back with 31 points.

Two players managed to score a 2, and shared the prize money, Dan Evans on the par 3, 7<sup>th</sup> hole, and Chris Martin on the same hole.

The top guest prize for the AM Stableford was won by a margin of 7 points by Bruce Peacock, playing off 13 hc with a score of 37 points.

The top guest prize for the PM Stableford was also won by Bruce Peacock, by a margin of 4 points with a score of 27 points.
